# **ANTI-DOPING POLICY**

## **BACKGROUND**

1. The Canadian Team Handball Federation (Handball Canada) is the governing body for the sport of Handball in Canada and is duly recognized by the Government of Canada as the sole National Sport Governing Body.
2. Should any discrepancy occur between the English and French version of the documents the English version shall prevail.

## **POLICY**

1. Handball Canada has adopted the Canadian Anti-Doping Program (CADP) as its primary domestic anti-doping policy. Administered on behalf of Handball Canada by the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport (CCES), the CADP is fully compliant with the World Anti-Doping Code, International Standards and Guidelines as they may exist from time to time. 2. In addition, Handball Canada, as a member federation of the International Handball Federation (IHF), must also be fully compliant with the IHF anti-doping rules. The IHF anti-doping rules may apply to certain members of Handball Canada in certain situations. The IHF anti-doping rules are fully compliant with the World Anti-Doping Code, International Standards and Guidelines as they may exist from time to time. 3. In the event of a conflict between other anti-doping policies established by Handball Canada and the CADP and/or the IHF anti-doping rules, the rules of the CADP or the IHF shall prevail, as applicable.
