No team is refused unless there are not enough registrations for a category or it is already complete. If this is the case, we will contact you.

Rules

NO INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR WILL BE TOLERATED UNDER PENALTY OF IMMEDIATE EXPULSION OF THE PLAYER OR EVEN THE TEAM.

The organizing committee reserves the right to upgrade a team that is under classified.

- 1.1 RINGUETTE QUÉBEC regulations will be applied during the Pink Ring ringette tournament.
- 1.2 Any late player must report to the registrar for verification and be ready to play before the start of the second period, otherwise she will not be able to get on the ice.
- 1.3 Teams and coaches must present themselves one (1) hour before the game (1/2 hour for the first part of the day) and the coach and his team must present themselves to the registrar for registration. If the team does not have a coach, the team manager must introduce herself.
- 1.4 The coach or team manager will indicate the captain, assistants and goalkeeper before each game. The coach will enter the five (5) players for the shootout on the scoresheet before the FINAL. (Identified and numbered)
- 1.5 Coaches must ensure that players wear the required regulatory equipment.
- 1.6 If there is a delay in the schedule, the organizing committee reserves the right to redo the ice every two (2) games.
- 1.7 If the two (2) teams that meet have jerseys of the same color, the visiting team will have to change jerseys. If necessary, sport bibs will be provided by the organizing committee.
- 1.8 Each team is entitled to a minimum of seven (7) players registered on the scoresheet and seated on the bench to start the game, otherwise the offending team will lose its game by default.
- 1.9 A maximum of three (3) people will be allowed behind the players' bench. (16 years and over)
- 1.10 During a misconduct and/or match punishment, there will be an immediate expulsion of the player.
- 1.11 Any violation of the regulations will result in disqualification of the team.
- 1.12 No protests will be accepted.

GAMES

- 2.1 Teams must be ready to play fifteen (15) minutes before the scheduled game time. Upon arrival on the ice, two (2) timed minutes will be allowed for warm-up before the start of the game and a timeout of one (1) minute between each regulation and additional period.
- 2.2 As soon as there is a difference of seven (7) points in the score, the game continues in CONTINUOUS TIME UNTIL THE END OF THE GAME. But the penalties remain in timed periods. However, the scoreboard will display the score with a difference of (7) scoring points. For tournament calculation purposes, a maximum difference of seven (7) points will be counted. However, the authentic result will be recorded on the score sheet.
- 2.3 All games must to be finished.

Rules

2.4 Before the start of the game, the coach/manager establishes his order of players for shots against the goalkeeper. The first five (5) players must be numbered from 1 to 5.

In the event of an injury during the game, the adult officials ensure that they have five (5) players numbered before the confrontation.

A draw (heads or tails) will be made before the start of the confrontation and the winning team of the draw has the choice of starting or ending the confrontation.

The team with the most goals is declared the winner.

If the tie persists, the coach has the freedom to choose any player thereafter. The first tiebreaker ends the game. It is allowed to always take the same player.

PLEASE NOTE: Each team will have executed the same number of throws before a team is declared the winner

RANKING

2.5 For a winning game = 2 points
For a drawn game = 1 point
For a lost game = 0 points
For a winning game by default = 2 points
For a game lost by default = 0 points

2.6 Game won by default, a score of seven (7) goals for and zero (0) against is indicated.

RULES FOR FINALS

If there is a tie after (2) regulation periods, an overtime of five (5) minutes with five (5) players will take place. If the tie persists, a shootout will then be necessary.
