Re: **High School Goalie Exceptions**

The AHAI High School Committee has the responsibility and right to make exceptions for goalies participation in high school hockey, based on AHAI Rules and Regulations, Article I, Section F, (Rosters), rule 13. This form must be submitted in writing (mail or electronic) to the HS Chairperson for consideration of this exception.

Protocol: Due to the shortage and unequal distribution of goaltenders, and the critical nature of goalie availability to the survival of a high school team, AHAI's high school committee will allow certain exceptions to the high school roster rule – "High School team – made up solely of players attending the same high school". (AHAI Rules and Regulations, Article I, Section C, paragraph 7.)

If a goaltender has attended high school tryouts and has been "cut" from his high school program – he may then be considered "available" for placement, by AHAI's high school committee, with another "target" high school hockey program that is in need of a goaltender to complete its roster (having no goaltenders, or having only a single goalie on their roster).

This exception is made for a single season only! The goaltender MUST return to his High School Hockey program the following year.
