- Suspensions Carry over from one year to another, it is league games that count towards the suspensions, exhibition games do not count. Graduating player suspensions carry over to the next level of hockey that player is playing after grade 12 – due to Hockey Manitoba. It is the team responsibility to sit a suspended player when the infraction occurs, don't wait until Doug sends the official word. What happens to a player/team that should suspend a player but plays in the next game is listed in the constitution.
 - It was noted there is a difference between a game misconduct and a game ejection.

b.) Play-off structure - League
